We will meet on Thursday, **March 18th** to discuss "America's First Daughter" by Stephanie Dray and Laura Kamoie. "America's First Daughter" is the fascinating, untold story of Thomas Jefferson's eldest daughter, Martha "Patsy" Jefferson Randolph. From her earliest days, Patsy Jefferson knows that though her father loves his family dearly, his devotion to his country runs deeper still. As Jefferson's oldest daughter, she becomes his helpmate, protector, and constant companion in the wake of her mother's death. It is in Paris, at the glittering court, that fifteen-year-old Patsy learns about her father's troubling liaison with Sally Hemings, a slave girl her own age. Meanwhile, Patsy has fallen in love--with her father's protégé William Short, a staunch abolitionist and ambitious diplomat. Torn between love, principles, and the bonds of family, Patsy questions whether she can choose a life as William's wife and still be a devoted daughter. Her choice will follow her in the years to come, to Virginia farmland, Monticello, and even the White House.
